Nevada Arts Advocates was founded as a state-wide organization in 1977 and now celebrating its 34th year is proud of the outreach and education the organization has brought to Nevadans.

Nevada Arts Advocates exists to encourage Nevadans to participate in and enjoy the arts. We develop and support cultural and educational activities designed to sustain funding and foster appreciation of the arts. We work to expand and enhance access to arts opportunities through public awareness, advocacy and outreach.

Initiated in 1987 by Nevada Arts Advocates, Arts Day in Nevada brings Nevada citizens from all corners of Nevada to Carson City during the Legislative session. The opportunity to sit with a Senator and Assemblyman during the morning session and share the cultural story of each community is a rare privilege. Arts enthusiasts can then join as we salute Nevada's Legislators for the support of culture in Nevada at a Legislative luncheon.

Nevada Arts Advocates has a scholarship program now in its eighth year which awards scholarships to graduating seniors who wish to continue their studies in the arts. Scholarships have been awarded to students from Henderson, Lovelock, Las Vegas, Boulder City, Carson City, Winnemucca, Pahrump, Sparks, Elko, Owyhee, Stateline, Reno, Mesquite, Gardnerville, Minden and Virginia City. In 2008 NAA began a Teacher Enrichment Program to assist with financial grants for teachers to attend conference in the arts. The Classroom Arts Enrichment Program was also initiated giving funds to classrooms for special cultural programs.
